Pastor's Page

We started 2023 by receiving Star Words as part of our worship on Epiphany Sunday. Words to guide us through the year. Words to allow us to reflect and ponder how God might be calling us forward. As 2023 comes to a close and a new year begins, I invite us to think back to the Star Words that we drew at the beginning of the year and see how it has guided us. My word was "radiate." Radiate means to send out rays, to shine brightly, to project or glow with joy. As I reflect back, I pray that I was able to radiate God's love and Christ's light into the world. I pray that I was able to glow with joy in some dark corners. During our worship service on January 7th, we will have the opportunity to hear stories from others in our congregation about how their Star Word guided them this year. If you would like to share your story, please let me know. At the end of the service, we will draw new words for 2024.

THERE ARE SEVERAL THEOLOGICAL STATEMENTS BEING MADE IN THIS TRADITION:

The Magi followed a star, which ultimately led them to Jesus. Therefore, we too use all the resources we have available to us—including creative prayer practices and intention words for the new year—to move closer to Jesus.

We trust that God uses multiple ways to guide us and speak to us. Star words are one such lens that might provide us a way to look for God in our midst, both actively and in hindsight.

We trust that it is often easy to miss God in our daily midst. Having an intention word to consider both in present days, as well as to reflect on at the end of the year, allows for us to see God in ways we may not have seen God before. This is the greatest gift.

We know that the most common prayer practice for many involves speaking to God as opposed to silence or contemplation. We believe that star words invite a new prayer rhythm of reflection and review that can be a powerful new way to connect with God.

By not looking or sorting through the star words at their selection, we practice the spiritual task of receiving. It is not us that are in control in this moment. Instead, we trust that God is present, and we let go of our desire to cultivate or control.

What Star Word might you draw this year? How might you draw closer to God with this new prayer practice?

Hello youth families!

Can you believe 2024 is just around the corner? That means it's time to plan for FaithX!

We are looking at two FaithX options for the youth:

Junior High- Palmyra, PA July 17-21 Senior High- North Fort Myers, FL July 14-20

FaithX registration opens January 10 at 7pm. We will have a registration party at the church so we can all register together as spots for each FaithX are limited. I will provide more information regarding registration as we get closer to the 10th. We will need male and female advisors for both trips. I'm happy to be a female advisor for either group. Please let me know if you are willing to be an advisor as you will also need to register on the 10th.

We are planning to drive to Palmyra. If you volunteer to be an advisor for the junior high FaithX please also let me know if you would be willing to drive the church van.

Below is more information about the two FaithX options:

Junior High- Capital Area Therapeutic Riding Association creates riding experiences for individuals of all ages who experience disabilities. We will assist with the care of the farm's animals, maintain stalls and paddocks, clean water troughs, re-stock hay stations, visit with the goats, brush the donkeys, and more! In the evenings we may visit Hershey's Chocolate World, have a pool party, or relax by a campfire. On Sunday, we will participate in worship with Palmyra Church of the Brethren.

Senior High- ECHO is growing hope from the ground up. Their many initiatives seek to equip small-scale farmers with self-sustainable hunger solutions and they guide the world's agricultural community by providing hands-on training. As we work alongside staff and interns to aid in construction projects and maintain ECHO's fields and gardens, we will learn about practical and innovative ways of producing food that have positively impacted millions of lives around the world.



FAITHX Registration opens January 10th!



VOICE Update—James Pearlstein



Team Gathering in January:

Prince William County VOICE Leaders will be meeting on January 11 from 1-2:30 pm at St Paul UMC. Every institution is encouraged to have 1-2 leaders at this meeting. If you are interested in attending, please contact Pastor Mandy.

Affordable Housing Trust Fund:

Exciting news! VOICE and our allies have been actively working towards establishing the county's first Affordable Housing Trust Fund and shaping related policies. We have recently learned that the county approved to allocate an **initial \$5 million to the Trust**

Fund at its BOCS meeting on 12/19. While there's still work ahead to build a truly robust fund, this marks a crucial first step and signals the Board's commitment to prioritizing the Trust Fund.

We attribute this positive development to the collective efforts of VOICE and our allies, including the Northern Virginia Affordable Housing Alliance, Wellington Development, and Tenants and Workers United. Despite being heavily distracted by the major data center votes, we've kept the Affordable Housing Trust Fund on the forefront for the BOCS, election candidates, and key county staff.

The status of the larger Affordable Housing Ordinance is currently much less clear, with the Board likely to focus on it in the first quarter of 2024.

Crisis Receiving Center:

As we gear up for January's General Assembly, the Prince William County Board of Supervisors has prioritized securing funding for the much-needed youth component of the CRC as their number one appropriations request from the state.

VOICE has been informed that the funding for the youth component is detailed in the county's budget request materials. The county has secured approximately half of the required total (\$5 million) for the youth wing of the CRC and is asking that the state contribute the remaining funding. Details on which PWC delegation members will carry the budget amendment will be shared as soon as available.

During the General Assembly, there will be opportunities, both in-person in Richmond and virtually, to support VOICE's priorities, including the youth component of the CRC. Dates are yet to be finalized.

Save the Date: Annual Meeting - March 3rd, 3-5pm:

Formal notice will follow, but please mark your calendars for VOICE's Annual Meeting on **Sunday**, **March 3rd**, **from 3-5pm**. The event, a significant gathering, is likely to be held in Fairfax this year.


