Pastor's Page

From the "Guidelines for Sabbath Rest: 2002 Church of the Brethren" Statement:

"The term sabbath comes from the Hebrew verb *shabbat*, which means primarily to cease. A second meaning is rest. God "rested on the seventh day from all his work," implying that those whom God should do the same by ceasing to work and resting on the seventh day. The people of Israel understood it that way. Observing the sabbath was a special celebration for them.

One of the Ten Commandments is about the sabbath. This Exodus passage goes on to say the entire family, the servants, and even the animals are to observe the sabbath.

The sabbath is a time to abstain completely from everyday work. It is a time to relax mind, body, and soul in order to be filled, nourished, and freed from worry about how one is doing. Like the biblical sabbath, sabbath rest is not running away from life and its problems; it is an opportunity to receive grace to face them. It is a time to rely on God, a time to let God be God in one's living. Life becomes meaningless and humdrum without God at the center. The hectic daily pace affects the lives of everyone, including pastors, causing people to lose contact with their core values and commitments. Tensions drain away when one is able and willing to commit all things into God's hands, especially during the time of a special sabbath rest. As the pastoral leader spends time immersing herself in God's love, she can return to work with a renewed sense of joy about ministry."

As I enter into my 12-week Sabbatical, I invite all of us into a time of Sabbath Rest. We have a great line-up of preachers for Sunday worship who will offer a new voice for listening to God's Word. My prayer is that you will come with ears open to hear, hearts open to each other, and minds open to learn something new. When I return on August 7th, I am looking forward to hearing all your stories during this sabbath rest, and I will share mine!

So then there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God.





"Blessings!" from Your Mid-Atlantic District Leadership Team (LT): From time to time, the LT will share with you what is happening in the District, as well as items of business we are considering. LT Meeting: The LT met on January 28 in the District office. It was wonderful to meet in person for the first time since the pandemic (with a zoom option). One of the highlights on our agenda were interviews with Philip Curran (University Park) and Scott Linton (Union Bridge) who were seeking ordination. They each gave a meditation and described their journey of faith. The LT had an opportunity to ask them questions about their application for ordination and then we voted unanimously to accept them for ordination. The next step will be a vote in their congregations. Other agenda items included a discussion of the District's financial status, progress on interim and pastoral placements, and a report from the District Executive Minister (DEM) Search Committee. Melvin Cheshire, our District Moderator, discussed planning efforts already underway for District conference, which will be at Manassas COB on October 6 and 7.

Jesus in the Neighborhood: One of the inspiring "Jesus in the neighborhood" stories in our District is what Martin and Sharon Hutchison and Community of Joy have been doing in Salisbury, MD. Martin received the Wicomico County Public Schools Friend of Education award recently for the many ways his congregation has partnered with the community. The video of Martin getting the award
